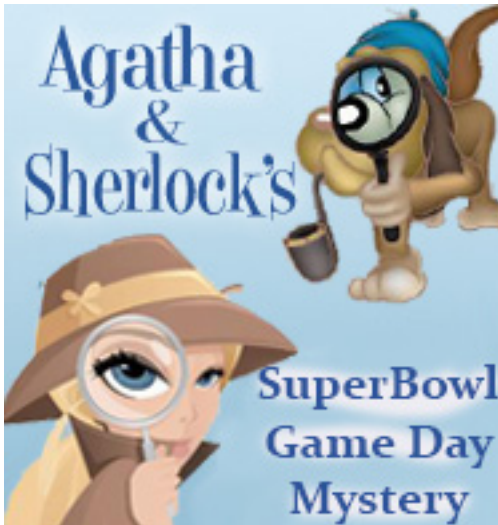

SuperBowl Game Day "Mystery at the Bowl"



Join Agatha and Sherlock as they prepare to find, cut, piece and sew together this new 2014 SuperBowl Game Day Mystery! We do have several clues that will help you along. Please prepare for your Super-Bowl Game Day Mystery as much as is provided. Then, come back on Game Day (Sunday, February 2, 2014) for a super fun time!

We have a few clues that Agatha and Sherlock have found already:

1. **Quilter Level** - We know that this is the perfect quilt for a new beginner quilter, but also fun and quick enough for the most savvy of mystery quilters.
2. **Quilt Size** - The size of the quilt is a comfortable 56" x 72". Of course, you can double your quilt to make it a generous 80" x 80" quilt... but that would take a bit more time.

3. **This is a 3 Color Quilt.** One fabric will need to be a dark-dark (like black, Navy, dark brown, etc) -and a solid is best, although not required. But, the other two can be coordinating contrasts .. such as Rose and Pink, Blue and Yellow, Purple and Lavendar. Or, perhaps your SuperBowl team colors! School colors? Two favorite fabrics? Batiks will also be beautiful in this design.

The options are endless, and you can go with larger florals, smaller prints, or even solids. If you go with solids for your two coordinating contrasts, we would recommend that you have several in a colorway. For instance, should you be a Denver Broncos fan, you may want to go with Black, and then several oranges and several blues .. this will give your quilt a little more depth. And, it is a good way to use your scraps.

Perhaps you are all about Americana? Then a Navy Dark, with Red and White Contrasts ... beautiful!

Of course, you will need to place your order early so you have them on Game Day!

Fabric Requirements

Color Fabric #1 - 1 1/4 yards
Color Fabric #2 - 1 1/4 yards
Dark/Solid Fabric - 2 yards
Binding - 2/3 yards
Backing - 4 yards

Cutting / Preparation

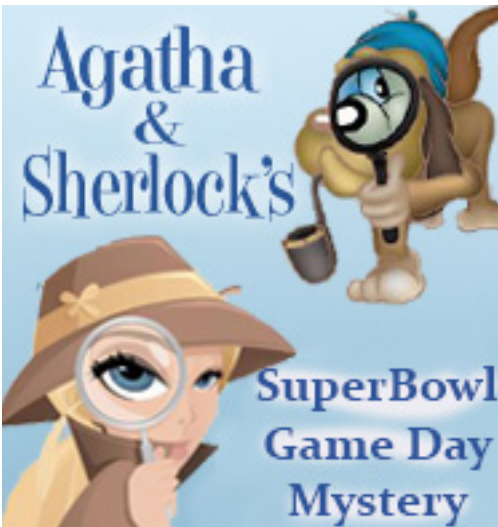
1. If you think your dark fabric could bleed the dark dyes, we recommend a pre-wash on all fabrics.
2. Fabric 1 - Cut 9 Strips, each 4 1/2" x 42"
From 6 of the above strips, cut a total of 24) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips
3. Fabric 2 - Cut 9 Strips, each 4 1/2" x 42"
From 6 of the above strips, cut a total of 24) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips
4. Dark Fabric - Cut 7 Strips, each 4 1/2" x 42"
Cut 12 Strips, each 2 1/2" x 42"
5. Binding - Cut 7 Strips, each 2 1/2" x 42"
